AGM & WORKSHOP

ETN's Annual General Meeting (AGM) & Workshop will take place in Brussels, Belgium, on 29-30 March 2022 – make sure to pencil in the date! The AGM will be held in a hybrid format on 29 March, and the Workshop will be organised as a physical meeting on the following day. This will be an important event, as the new ETN Board for 2022-2024 will be elected during the AGM. The call for Board election candidates will be launched later this week – more details will be circulated shortly.

SUPERCRITICAL CO₂ WORKING GROUP

ETN's Supercritical CO₂ Working Group covers the whole value chain of the sCO₂ power cycle use and aims to act as a platform for ongoing global demo projects. The Working Group launched a review survey in November 2021 to identify the needs and recommendations of our stakeholders to support the uptake of sCO₂ technology and its associated market requirements. The outcome of this initiative will be shared in an aggregated form and will be used to better address the needs of the sCO₂ community. The survey results will also facilitate efficient communication with the European policymakers.
